The Code of Conduct outlines the standard of behaviour expected by Familystay Australia . It is designed to assist individuals to understand their responsibilities and obligations and provide guidance on expected behaviour in Homestay , or assistance if faced with an ethical dilemma or conflict of interest in their hosting Involving colleagues, students and School .

The code provides standards for the way individuals must conduct themselves and provides a practical set of protocols to help individuals make decisions in their day to day work , what ever role they fulfil . The code does not seek to encompass all possible scenarios , however., it provides a set of principles to guide Hosts on acceptable and unacceptable behaviour . (also attached)

Treat others with respect, value difference at Familystay Australia meets its obligations under State and Commonwealth legislation

Take all practicable steps to protect children / students from child abuse

Treat all people with dignity , respect , courtesy and sensitivity to their rights

Never treat anyone unfavourably because they have brought a genuine complaint of improper behaviour

Never accept any gifts , reward or entertainment if it could create an obligation or expectation or be perceived to create an obligation or expectation ,
